CAN YOU INSULATE YOUR WALLS WITHOUT REMOVING DRYWALL?

Most insulations cannot be installed with drywall intact. Usually, the entire wall cavity must be exposed for insulation to be installed.

- Batt
- Blown-in
- Spray foam

Some insulations can be installed with drywall *mostly* intact.

- Dense pack cellulose
- Injection foam

We do not recommend insulating your walls without removing drywall.

Drywall can hide a variety of problems.

Unless your walls have zero insulation, start with more accessible areas of your home.
