CAN YOU SPRAY FOAM INSULATION ON DUCTWORK?

SPRAY FOAM DOES ADHERE TO DUCTWORK.

Spray foam is sometimes used to help insulate and air-seal ductwork.

- Coating the duct eliminates some heat load.
- Attic ductwork can take on significant heat load in summer.

WE GENERALLY DO NOT RECOMMEND SPRAYING DUCTWORK.

For the insulation and air-sealing to actually benefit your ducts, the foam needs to encapsulate the ductwork.

Inaccessible ducts do not allow for spraying a full 360 degrees around.

 Instead, you can encapsulate your attic to eliminate excess heat load.
