DO I NEED A DEHUMIDIFIER IF I ENCAPSULATE?

Encapsulated crawl spaces do need a dehumidification system.

For the crawl space to have conditioned air, some HVAC equipment is needed to do the job.

IT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE A DEHUMIDIFIER.

If there is any existing HVAC in your crawl space, it can be tapped into to condition the air.

Otherwise, you will need to purchase a dehumidifier. These systems are not sold at home improvement stores and cost between \$1,500 and \$3,000.
