## IS SPRAY FOAM INSULATION FLAMMABLE?

Spray foam is combustible, but it has a Class I fire rating since it is a building material.

Closed cell has a built-in ignition barrier, and open cell can have ignition barrier coatings added when required by building codes.

Spray foam is also usually covered by a thermal barrier, such as drywall.

Spray foam insulation does not increase the risk of fire. In the case of fire, the thermal barrier (drywall) would have to be burned through first.
