MUST ATTIC INSULATION BE REMOVED BEFORE SPRAY FOAM?

Yes, existing attic insulation must be removed before installing spray foam.

Spray foam insulation works by adhering to a surface. This adhesion is like glue and provides an air-seal.

If the surface isn't clean and dry, the adhesion will fail.

Even if spray foam could be installed on top of existing batt or blown-in insulation, it would be wise to remove existing insulation.

Current insulation may be hiding rodent droppings.
